

## **CIUTAT DE PALMA ANTONI GELABERT VISUAL ARTS AWARD 2012**

1. The Ciutat de Palma “Antoni Gelabert” Visual Arts Award 2012 will award one 12,000-euro endowment to a single winner.

2. The prize is indivisible and the jury can not declare void, except as motivated. Their decision is final.

3. The Ciutat de Palma Award for Visual Arts will be announced in the event of the Ciutat de Palma Awards 2013.

4. The winner shall be obliged to transfer ownership of the prize-winning work to Palma City Council, together with corresponding material and intellectual property rights and the right to its publication, exhibition, reproduction etc. The award shall be subject to the tax regulations in force at the time.

5. Artists interested in participating must submit a dossier with the following materials:

a. Academic and professional resume with the artist’s full name, NIF, address and telephone number.

b. A body of work, not to exceed five pieces, with corresponding captions.

c. Photographs of other pieces from recent years with corresponding captions.

d. Catalogs from recent exhibits.

e. Copies of any appropriate bibliographies or reviews.

6. Dossiers will be accepted from 10 am to 2 pm, Monday through Friday, between 1st September and 11th October 2012 at the Palma Espai d’Art Foundation headquarters in Casal Solleric, passeig del Born 27, 07012 Palma, tel. 971 722 092, e-mail: [solleric@palma.es](mailto:solleric@palma.es). Dossiers should be sent or delivered labelled with the indication CIUTAT DE PALMA ANTONI GELABERT VISUAL ARTS AWARD 2012.

Artists will be given a receipt upon submission of their dossier. Dossiers can also be sent by mail or messenger – postage and packing paid– to the aforementioned address. Dossiers sent by mail, postage paid, will be accepted only if postmarked on or before 11th October. Once the panel of judges has made their decision, materials will be returned at the express request and expense of the artist.

7. The jury, which will be chosen by the Mayor of Palma, will be announced before the submission deadline.

8. The jury, based on the dossiers submitted of the artists’ body of work, will select pieces to participate in an exhibit during the Saint Sebastian Festival in 2013. Their selection will not be made public before the inauguration of this exhibition.

9. Artists must submit the selected pieces by a deadline to be established by the curator of the exhibit, which will be at least seven days before the inauguration of the exhibition. The Palma City Council will assume all transportation costs for the piece, up to 210 euros per piece. (Corresponding receipts must be submitted to the Palma Espai d'Art Foundation no later than 15 days after the work has been returned to its owner).

10. The Palma Espai d'Art Foundation will have a team of professionals to set up the exhibition. Any special needs must be provided by the artist –audiovisual, informatics, lighting or of any other kind –.

11. Appropriate measures will be taken to safeguard and conserve the selected work, however the Palma City Council will not be responsible for any wear and tear or accidents that may occur while the pieces are in their custody.

12. Artists selected to participate in the exhibition will have no more than two months, from the exhibition's closing, to reclaim their work or arrange for its transport. The City Council will not be held responsible for work not claimed after this date.

13. By submitting a dossier to the Ciutat de Palma Antoni Gelabert Visual Arts Award 2012 artists accept these rules and regulations. The panel of judges will be free to interpret or add to them as they see fit.
